## **Removal of Export Permits**

The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection wishes to inform the public in general and, stakeholders in particular, that the Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment No.3) Regulations 2017 have been promulgated and are effective as from 14 August 2017. Consequently, an export permit from the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection will, henceforth, be required only in respect of the items listed below:-

- 1) Rice;
- 2) Wheat or Meslin flour;
- 3) Sand;
- 4) Limestone;
- 5) Cement;
- 6) Textile and textile-articles for export to USA and Canada; and
- 7) Rough diamonds.
