

Exclusion of Bidder to participate in a procurement exercise

The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection (Commerce Division) has decided not to invite Pascal Computer Services Ltd for bidding exercises for a period of four (4) months with effect from 21 August 2018 under Section 35(1A) and Sub section 7 of Directive No 35 of the Public Procurement Act (PPA) 2006.

Sub section no 7 of Directive No 35 refers:

“The decision to exclude the Supplier is recommended by a Performance Review Committee established by the Chief Executive of the Public Body. The Committee should have also determined that the Public Body has suffered prejudice from the poor performance of the supplier or the latter has failed to deliver the goods, works or services satisfactorily and demonstrate that excluding the supplier is fair and reasonable under the circumstance.”
