

## CONDITIONS ATTACHED ON APPROVAL OF SCRAP METAL COLLECTOR PERMIT

1. This permit is not transferable.
2. Any scrap metal Exporter/Dealer/Carrier should notify the Ministry upon cessation of activity of bearer of this permit and return same to the Ministry of Business, Enterprise, Commerce and Consumer Protection (Commerce Division).
3. The holder of this permit shall at all times carry it or a copy thereof by virtue of which he/she is authorized to act as a collector and use such collector badge as may be approved by the Permanent Secretary.
4. This permit is subject to such terms and conditions as the Permanent Secretary may impose.
5. Any breach of the above-mentioned condition(s) may automatically lead to the cancellation/revocation of the permit.

## CONDITIONS ATTACHED ON APPROVAL OF SCRAP METAL CARRIER PERMIT

1. The permit shall be affixed or cause to be affixed on a plate in a conspicuous position at the rear or in front of the vehicle/trailer and should be produced on demand to an officer of this Ministry or any Police Officer;
2. The plate shall be at least 60 cm in length and 15 cm in height, bearing the words "Scrap Metal Carrier" followed by the carrier permit number both the words and the figures in red on a white background;
3. The Permit shall not be transferable;
4. Any application for the renewal of the licence/permit shall be made within 30 days before its expiry, failing which a surcharge of 25 percent shall be applicable in addition to the yearly licence/permit fee. The licence/permit shall automatically lapse if not renewed within 30 days after the date of its expiry;
5. The licence or permit issued for the purpose of carrying the activities of scrap metal will be suspended if the holder of such licence/permit is reported to be in possession of any stolen item and shall be cancelled upon conviction;
6. Any breach of the above-mentioned condition(s) may automatically lead to the cancellation/revocation of the permit; and
7. **Note:** The Permanent Secretary may impose such other conditions as he may deem fit.

## CONDITIONS ATTACHED ON APPROVAL OF SCRAP METAL EXPORTER/DEALER LICENCE

1. Scrap metal received in the scrap yard should remain in its original form for at least a period of 3 days.
2. The licence shall not be transferable.
3. The licence or a copy thereof should be kept in a conspicuous place at the exporter's main office, sub-office and scrapyards.
4. Any scrap metal exporter shall keep at each place occupied by him as a scrapyards, a written record detailing all scrap metal received/processed or dispatched from that place.
5. Clearance to be obtained from the Water Resources Unit as regards water contamination.
6. Dangerous and hazardous wastes shall not be stored within the scrapyards.
7. The owner or operator should implement a programme to control insects, rodents, and/or any other pests by eliminating their breeding places and removing inaccessible materials which may serve as their food, by poisoning, spraying, trapping or by any other recognised and legal method.
8. The scrapyards should not give rise to noise, dust and environmental nuisances.
9. Employees should be provided with protective equipment as per requirements of the Ministry of Labour, Industrial Relations and Employment.
10. Any application for the renewals of the licence/permit shall be made within 30 days before its expiry, failing which a surcharge of 25 percent shall be applicable in addition to the yearly licence /permit fee. The licence/permit shall automatically lapse if not renewed within 30 days after the date of its expiry.
11. The licence or permit issued for the purpose of carrying the activities of scrap metal will be suspended if the holder of such licence/permit is reported to be in possession of any stolen item and shall be cancelled upon conviction.
12. Any breach of the above-mentioned condition(s) may automatically lead to the cancellation/revocation of the licence; and
13. **Note:** The Permanent Secretary may impose such other conditions as he may deem fit.
