

**THE CONSUMER PROTECTION
(PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under sections 3 and 35 of the
Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Consumer Goods) (Maximum Price) (Amendment) Regulations 2011.
2. In these regulations –

“principal regulations” means the Consumer Protection (Consumer Goods) (Maximum Price) Regulations 1998.
3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the Schedule to these regulations.
4. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 2011.

Made by the Minister on 29 June 2011.
