

Government Notice No. 123 of 2025

**THE CONSUMER PROTECTION
(PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the
Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Pharmaceutical Products) (Maximum Mark-Up) (Amendment) Regulations 2025.
2. In these regulations –
 - “principal regulations” means the Consumer Protection (Pharmaceutical Products) (Maximum Mark-Up) Regulations 2023.
3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definitions –
 - “cost price” means the price of a consumer goods as determined in the manner specified in Part II of the Second Schedule;
 - “maximum mark-up” means the percentage determined by the Minister under regulation 4;
 - “maximum retail price”, in relation to a consumer goods, means the aggregate of the cost price and the mark-up;
4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (1), by inserting, after the words “Minister shall”, the words “, for the Island of Mauritius,”.
5. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 4, the following new regulation –

4A. (1) The Minister shall, for the Island of Rodrigues, determine the maximum mark-up applicable for any pharmaceutical product in the manner specified in the Fifth Schedule.

(2) The maximum mark-up determined under paragraph (1) shall be the percentage of the cost price which may be added to the cost price of the pharmaceutical product.

6. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (2), by deleting the words “Fifth Schedule” and replacing them by the words “Sixth Schedule”.

7. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after the Fourth Schedule, the Fifth Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations, the existing Fifth Schedule being renumbered as Sixth Schedule.

8. These regulations shall come into operation on 15 December 2025.
