
Government Notice No. 240 of 2020

**THE CONSUMER PROTECTION
(PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the
Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Fixed Penalty Notice) Regulations 2020.
2. In these regulations –
“Act” means the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act.
3. For the purpose of section 30A of the Act –
 - (a) the Fixed Penalty Notice shall be in the form set out in the First Schedule;
 - (b) the fine, in respect of the offences specified in the second column of the Second Schedule, shall be as specified in the third column of that Schedule.
4. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 November 2020.

Made by the Minister on 12 October 2020.

SECOND SCHEDULE

[Regulation 3(b)]

FINE

OFFENCE	(Rs)
1. Selling or supplying controlled goods at a price higher than that which has been fixed – section 3 of the Act	2,000
2. Selling or supplying controlled goods at a price which includes a mark-up which exceeds the maximum mark-up – section 4 of the Act	2,000
3. Charging VAT where VAT is not chargeable, or charging a higher rate or amount of VAT than is lawfully chargeable, whilst selling or supplying goods – section 6 of the Act	2,000
4. Failing to affix price label on goods exposed for sale or failing to make available to a customer the price of services offered, in accordance with section 7 of the Act – section 7 of the Act	2,000
5. Selling goods at a price higher than the price shown on the label affixed pursuant to section 7 of the Act – section 8 of the Act	2,000
6. Giving misleading indication as to the price at which goods are sold or supplied – section 9 of the Act	2,000
7. Keeping goods specified in the Third Schedule to the Act on premises other than on trading premises or registered warehouse – section 13 of the Act	2,000

| 9. Failing to display a specimen of every goods kept for sale/stored in registered warehouse, in that part of the trading premises to which the public has access – section 17 of the Act | 2,000 |
| 10. Failing to put up notice accessible to the public and/or conforming with section 18(2) of the Act – section 18 of the Act | 1,000 |
| 11. Using Liquefied Petroleum Gas in small cylinders other than for domestic purposes – regulation 3(a) of the Consumer Protection (Use of Liquefied Petroleum Gas in Small Cylinders) Regulations 2012 | 5,000 |
| 12. Failing to submit a return of cost within 10 working days – regulation 3(1)(a) of the Consumer Protection (Consumer Goods) (Maximum Mark-up) Regulations 1998 | 5,000 |
