## THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) (Amendment) Regulations 2019.
- In these regulations –
   "principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) Regulations 2017.
- 3. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (3)(f), in the definition of "competent authority", in paragraph (c), by inserting, after the word "Singapore", the words ", United Arab Emirates".
- 4. The Ninth Schedule to the principal regulations is amended
  - (a) in item 1, in the third column, by adding the following new paragraphs

  - (3) EAA SingaporeSTA Vehicle Inspection Centre,302 Sing Ming Road, 575627, Singapore
- (c) in item 3, in the third column, by adding the following new paragraphs, the existing provision being numbered as paragraph (1) -
  - (2) Intertek International Ltd.

    Brentwood
    Essex CM14 5NQ
    England
  - (3) EAA UK Ltd
    Capstan House, Tilbury,
    Essex, RM18 7HL, United Kingdom
- (d) by adding the following new item and its corresponding entries -

- 5. (1) Regulations 3 and 4 insofar as it relates to items 1(5), 2(3) and 3(3) shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2019.
- (2) Regulation 4 insofar as it relates to items 1(4), 2(2) and 3(2) shall be deemed to have come into operation on 13 December 2018.
