**THE CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 4(1) of  
the Consumer Protection Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Toys (Safety) (Amendment) Regulations 2025.
2. In these regulations –  
“principal regulations” means the Toys (Safety) Regulations 2021.
3. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following regulation –

**11. Warnings indications of precautions**

- (1) No person shall –
  - (a) import any toy unless, at the time of shipment, it bears the appropriate warnings and indication of precautions to be taken during use, in either the English or French language, as specified in the Third Schedule; or
  - (b) manufacture any toy locally unless it bears the appropriate warnings and indications of precautions to be taken during use, in either the English or French language, as specified in the Third Schedule.
- (2) No person shall offer for sale, sell, distribute, or otherwise supply any toy that does not comply with the

requirements regarding warning and indication of precautions required under paragraph (1).

4. These regulations shall come into operation on 22 August 2025.
