

*Government Notice No. 106 of 2023*

**THE CONSUMER PROTECTION  
(PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under sections 3 and 35 of  
the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Control of Price of Petroleum Products) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 2023.

2. In these regulations –

“principal regulations” means the Consumer Protection (Control of Price of Petroleum Products) Regulations 2011.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the definition of “petroleum product” and replacing it by the following definition –

“petroleum product” –

(a) means –

(i) Mogas sold on the local market (Motor Gasoline); or

(ii) Gas Oil sold on the local market (Diesel);

(b) includes, for the purpose of regulation 8B, Premium Grade Mogas sold on the local market (Motor Gasoline);

4. Regulation 8A of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after paragraph (1), the following new paragraph –

(1A) Where the Minister approves a recommendation of the Committee, he shall fix the retail price of a petroleum product accordingly.

**5.** The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 8A, the following new regulation –

**8B.** The price of Premium Grade Mogas, per litre, sold by the Corporation to oil companies, shall be –

- (a) the corresponding amount of Mogas in the item “Transfer price to oil companies” to the Schedule;
- (b) an additional amount as may be agreed between the Corporation and an oil company; and
- (c) any value added tax payable under paragraphs (a) and (b).

**6.** These regulations shall come into operation on 28 July 2023.
