## THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

## Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2005.
- 2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Export Control) Regulations 2000.

3. The principal regulations are amended in regulation 5A, by deleting subparagraph (c) and replacing it by the following subparagraph -

(c) issue a Kimberley Process Certificate to the applicant for a maximum validity period of not more than 60 calendar days from the date of issue, subject to such conditions as he may deem fit to impose including a condition that the rough diamonds be exported in a sealed tamper-proof container.
